**LERAY McALLISTER CRITICAL LAND CONSERVATION FUND
PRE-APPLICATION DUE
MONDAY, MAY 14, 2007**

The Utah Quality Growth Commission announces the opening of a new application cycle. Pre-Applications are due Monday, May 14, 2006 by 5:00 PM. The LeRay McAllister Critical Land Conservation Fund provides grants and loans to preserve or restore critical open or agricultural land in Utah. Matching funds are required.

Eligible applicants are counties, cities, towns, the Utah Department of Natural Resources, the Utah Department of Agriculture and Food, and charitable organizations that qualify as tax exempt under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Applying involves several steps. Before starting, be sure you have read through all the documents listed here:

- Application Checklist
- Application Form and Evaluation Criteria
- McAllister Fund Defining Principles
- Eligible Costs Policy
